1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0065 dated 08.06.2020, registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sadar, Rajpura, District Patiala.
3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move an application for regular bail with directions being issued to the trial Court to consider and decide the application for regular bail as and when moved, as expeditiously as possible.
4. The same is not opposed to by Mr. Gaurav Garg Dhuriwala, Senior DAG, Punjab.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of an application for regular bail being moved, the learned trial Court to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
