Petitioners have filed this writ petition under Articles 226/227 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 10 as they have solemnized marriage on 19.10.2019 against their wishes.

On 20.07.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are receiving threats from respondent Nos.4 to 10 as they have entered into marriage on 19.10.2019, against the wishes of private respondents.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Mr. Harsimar Singh Sitta, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Counsel for the petitioners

undertakes to forward the complete copy of the petition to the office of Advocate General Punjab through e-mail, during the course of the day.

Learned State counsel prays for time to verify the facts and the existence of alleged threat.

On his request, adjourned to 28.07.2020.”

Learned State counsel has apprised that statements of petitioners have been recorded wherein they have stated that they are happily residing at the residence of Kirpal Singh (father of petitioner No.2) and they have no threat from private respondents. Copies of the statements have been produced.

In view of the stand of learned State counsel, nothing survives in the petition for adjudication.

Disposed off as infructuous.
