Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5 and other relatives as they have married against their wishes.

On 20.07.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, learned State counsel states that the statements of respondent Nos.4 and 5 (parents of petitioner No.2) have been recorded, wherein they have stated that they do not have any objection to the marriage between the petitioners.
