ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0189 dated 28.06.2020, under Sections 307, 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that no overt act has been attributed to the petitioners and they were alleged to have raised 'lalkara'. The petitioners are parents of the co-accused Happy, who along with Karamjit Singh, is stated to have caused injuries on the injured Taranjit Singh.

This Court, by the order dated 20.07.2020, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Santokh Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 20.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
