This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No 77 dated 17.04.2020 under Sections 304B IPC registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar (Rural).

As per the order dated 18.06.2020 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge (FTC) Amritsar (Annexure P-3), the marriage between the petitioner and Rupinder Kaur (deceased) took place in the year 2016 and out of their wedlock two children were born. The FIR was registered on the statement of Mandeep Singh brother of the deceased (Rupinder Kaur) who made clear cut that petitioner used to harass the deceased on the pretext of a motorcycle for him and even the deceased was turned out of the matrimonial home by the accused-petitioner and before 7/8 days from the date of occurrence the deceased Rupinder Kaur was left by her brother in the house of the accused. On 17.04.2020 the complainant and his relative Paramjit Singh had gone to the house of the deceased Rupinder Kaur at about 5:00

P.M. then they had seen that accused Satnam Singh was strangulating the deceased and was telling her that as she has not brought the motorcycle from her parental house so he has killed her and when the complainant and his relative Paramjit Singh tried to save her they saw that Rupinder Kaur has died and Satnam Singh ran away from the spot.

Learned counsel for the State informed that challan has been presented and charges are yet to be framed.

Keeping in view above, no case for grant of regular bail is made out at this stage. Hence petition is dismissed.
