Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.97, dated 16.04.2020, registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 506 IPC, (Section 325 and 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is an outcome of a quarrel between brothers due to a civil dispute. With the intervention of the respectable, the matter has been compromised and a petition for quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise bearing CRM No.M-39043 of 2020 has been filed wherein notice had been issued and it is listed on 21.01.2021.

Learned counsel for the complainant, however, contends that he is not aware of the compromise.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 21.07.2020, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join

the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Lekh Ram, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 21.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
