Counsel for the State submits that the statements of the private respondents have been recorded, according to which, they have no objection to the marriage which has been solemnized between the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that although the statements of the private respondents have been recorded, however, the petitioner still apprehend danger to their life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

The present petition is disposed of with an observation that the Station House Officer, Police Station Chabal, District Amritsar – respondent No.4, shall assess the threat perception of the petitioners, if any and take necessary steps in accordance with law, if required.
