Heard. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the matter is preponed today for hearing. Application stands disposed of.

CWP No. 10253 of 2020 (O&M)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case the respondents defer the enforcement of the on-line transfer policy dated 02.06.2020 for Gram Sachiv-2020 for three months, the petitioners' grievance would be satisfied.

Learned Senior Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of Haryana on instructions submits that the respondent-authorities undertake not to enforce the policy for a period of two months except viz.-viz. those who have already given their options and are willing to join the new place of posting during the intervening period.

Looking to the aforesaid statement made by the learned Senior Additional Advocate General for the State of Haryana and the prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the undertaking and the statement of the learned Senior Additional Advocate General is accepted with the modification that the period for which the transfer policy shall not be enforced is extended to three months.

With the aforesaid direction and observations, the petition filed by the petitioners stands disposed of.
