The petitioner-M/s Pasupati Spinning & Weaving Mills Ltd. (in short 'the Mill') has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court by virtue of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ of certiorari for quashing the sale circular dated 27.03.2020 (Annexure P-3).

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner as well as

counsel for the State and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with a direction to the respondents to duly consider and dispose off the representation dated 26.05.2020 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

During the intervening period, the petitioner would be paying, if any demand is raised by the respondent, to the extent of 70% of the demand, within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of the copy of this order and balance of 30% within a period of one month from that day including late charges, if any, so imposed as per rules.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
