The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

During the course of hearing, learned State counsel states at bar that the trial in this case has since been completed and the matter is listed for defence evidence for 13.08.2020.

Faced with the above situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has made statement withdrawing the present petition, however, a fervent prayer has been made that in case the judgment is not pronounced, the petitioner be allowed bail since she is custody for more than 02 years for an offence

under Section 304-B IPC. Keeping in view the same, the petitioner is allowed to withdraw the present petition.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, directions are issued to the trial Court to ensure that the trial is disposed off within month of August, 2020 and it is made clear that in case the trial judgment is not pronounced, the petitioner would be at liberty to come up before this Court on that ground afresh.
