The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.272, dated 5.12.2018, under Sections 452,506 IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Rojka Meo, District Nuh.

It has been mentioned in the head note that this is the first bail petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., however, as per the office report, this is not the first petition, rather it is the second petition for regular bail. A further perusal of the petition reveals that it has been categorically stated that no such or similar petition for grant of regular bail was filed by the petitioner before this Court or before the Hon'ble Supreme Court which is factually incorrect in view of the report sent by the Registry.

On a pointed query put to the learned counsel for the petitioner qua the concealment of the earlier petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C, this Court is not satisfied by the explanation given by the learned counsel that it was a typographical error.
