The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.37 dated 29.2.2020, registered at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar Rural, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985 (Section 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 added later on) and Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 and 420 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 31.7.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation and has been cooperating therewith. This is not disputed by the learned counsel for the State.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 31.7.2020, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 by him.
