1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.111 dated 08.06.2020, registered under Sections 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 26.08.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the Police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned DAG, Punjab, on instructions from *SI Darshan Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 26.08.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
5. In view of the statement of learned DAG, Punjab, order dated

26.08.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
