The petitioners are arrayed amongst the accused in FIR No. 288 dated 26.05.2020 on the file of Police Station Barwala, District Hisar, registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341 and 506 IPC. By way of this petition, they seek anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

Perusal of the FIR demonstrates that specific overt acts were attributed to the petitioners. The first petitioner is the wife of the complainant-victim while the second petitioner is her sister. They, along with the other accused, are stated to have caused grievous injuries to the complainant-victim. Section 149 IPC has also been pressed into service and the question of independently going by individual acts of each accused would not arise, whereby benefit of doubt could be extended to the

petitioners. This Court is therefore of the opinion that the petitioners cannot be shown any indulgence at this stage and they would necessarily have to undergo custodial interrogation to ascertain their role in the commission of the alleged offence.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
