The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No. 92 dated 09.06.2020 on the file of Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana, registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC. By way of this petition, he seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

One of the co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted anticipatory bail subject to conditions. Given the nature of the alleged offence, it would suffice if the petitioner joins and co-operates with the investigation and his custodial investigation may not be required.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No. 92 dated 09.06.2020 on the file of Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana, subject to the

petitioner furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer. The petitioner shall also comply with the mandate of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
