The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in relation to FIR No. 0426 dated 09.10.2018 on the file of Police Station Badshahpur, registered under Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

The petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender under Section 82 Cr.P.C on 04.11.2019. Further, the victim-girl named the petitioner as one of the perpetrators in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C and also her testimony before the trial Court in the case relating to the co-accused.

Given the aforesaid circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner would not be entitled to seek pre-arrest bail.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
