The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant them seniority, pay-fixation and notional consequential benefits with effect from the date when the other category candidates out of the same advertisement were appointed as Constables.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the aforesaid claim, petitioners have submitted a joint-representation dated 20.08.2019 (Annexure P-5). He relies upon the order dated 09.07.2019 passed in **CWP-14964-2019 (Sukhjinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and others)**, which was disposed of by this Court with a direction to the

At this stage, Ms. Sunint Kaur, A.A.G., Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa/competent authority to consider the claim of the petitioners so referred in the representation dated 20.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) and to decide the same by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law. It shall be appreciated if the aforesaid exercise is completed within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
