This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner herein and her family from her husband Jagjit Singh, as her husband and his family members were not happy with the dowry articles brought by the petitioner in her marriage.

It is stated in the petition that the petitioner was harassed by her husband on account of illegal demand of dowry and was being pressurized to bring ₹50,000/- and a motorcycle. It is also stated that an attempt was made to administer her with an intoxicating substance and her husband also sprinkled kerosene upon her to set her on fire, but she managed to save herself and ran away. Through this petition, it is prayed that protection be provided to the petitioner and her family at the hands of Jagjit Singh, who is

serving in the Haryana police.

No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State would argue that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner—Paramjeet Kaur has died on account of a liver disease she was suffering in the hospital. In fact, she was got discharged from the hospital against the medical advise.

Consequently, in view of the above statement made by the learned counsel for the respondent—State, this petition is dismissed.
