The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 32 dated 26.01.2020 under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Hisar Sadar, District Hisar.

By an order dated 21.07.2020 the petitioner herein had been directed to join investigation with a stipulation that he would comply with order dated 17.07.2020 passed in CRM-M-15050-2020. The petitioner had in fact challenged the order declaring him as proclaimed offender before this Court in CRM-M-15050-2020 which petition was dismissed by the High Court giving him a direction to surrender and join the proceedings before the trial Court however, giving liberty to the petitioner to file an application within a period of seven days for regular bail which was to be considered within a period of ten days thereafter.

It appears that the petitioner herein has not complied with the

order allowing him interim bail nor he has surrendered before the trial Court in terms of the direction issued in CRM-M-15050-2020. Consequently, this Court finds that the petitioner herein is not entitled to the discretionary relief of anticipatory bail in the aforesaid FIR.
