Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Having argued the matter at some length, counsel makes a statement that he would not be pressing the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Criminal Complaint No.4 of 23.1.2015 under Sections 498-A, 406, 34 I.P.C pending before J.M.I.C, Dasuya District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel, however, prays for indulgence of this Court that the petitioner would be ready and willing to surrender within a period of 5 days from today and if he thereafter files an application for regular bail, the same be decided forthwith.

As per statement made by counsel, instant petition is disposed of as not pressed.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner surrenders within a period of 5 days from today and thereafter files an application seeking bail, the competent court would decide the same in accordance with law and would make an earnest endeavor to expedite disposal of the same.
