Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.145 dated 10.05.2020 under Sections 307, 323, 336, 188, 270, 148 and 149 IPC, Section 51 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 22.07.2020, a co-ordinate Bench of this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 22.07.2020 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the

petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Virender Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 22.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
