B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and to move application for regular bail with directions to the trial Court to consider and decide the application for regular bail on receipt, as expeditiously as possible, preferably on the same day.
3. The same is not opposed to by Mr. Pradeep Prakash Chahar, DAG, Haryana, who is present.
4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is ***dismissed as withdrawn***, with the liberty as prayed for. In case, any application for regular bail is filed by the petitioner, the same be considered and decided by the learned trial Court, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably on the same day.
