Challenge in the present writ petition is to the adjustment regarding recovery on account of revision of rates by FCI due to expense of RO Paddy during Kharif Season 2017-18 (Annexures P-6 to P-8).

It is submitted that the adjustments are being made @12.50/- per quintal on account of transportation charges of paddy shifted against the release orders for crop year 2017-18. It is submitted that in ***CWP No. 9979 of 2020, M/s. Raghupati Food Products and others vs. State of Punjab and others decided on 17.07.2020*** and ***CWP No. 12890 of 2020, M/s. Shri Balaji Traders and others vs. State of Punjab and others decided on 27.08.2020***, directions have been issued to consider the representations of

the petitioners after hearing them and pass a speaking order within a period of 6 weeks.

Ms. Deepali Puri has put in appearance on behalf of respondents no. 5 and 6.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if similar directions are also issued in the present case.

Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Advocate appearing for the FCI submits that the competent authority would pass the necessary order as per the directions issued in the earlier cases and the present writ petition can be disposed of accordingly.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to respondents no. 3 and 4 to decide the representation (Annexure P-9) within prescribed period. It will be also open to the petitioner to file a supplementary and detailed representation regarding the claim. The interim protection granted vide order dated 23.07.2020 shall continue till the decision making process is complete.
