The petitioners in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.132 dated 30.06.2020 under Sections 323, 452, 341, 379, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC(Section 326 added subsequently) registered at Police Station Kotwali Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

On 23.07.2020 the following order was passed:-

“Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to pandemic Covid-19.

Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners –Kuldeep kaur @ Lakho and Shillo – in case FIR No.132 dated 30.06.2020 registered under Sections 323, 452, 341, 379, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added subsequently) at Police Station Kotwali, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

According to the prosecution, in the night of 29.06.2020 complainant Sukhdev Singh and his brother Balwinder Singh when were returning from the house of their grandmother and reached near their house, co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Sukhwinder Singh, Balwinder Singh armed with 'dattar', Jagtar

singh @ Labha Singh, Jogga Singh, Lakhbir Singh armed with 'dang', Tarlok Singh, Karnail Singh armed with swords and petitioners having brick-bats chased them and trespassing into house of the complainant, caused multiple grievous injuries with their respective weapons.

Learned counsel *inter alia* contends that allegations against the petitioners are of damaging glasses of house of the complainant by brick-batting. They did not cause any injury to the complainant or his brother. They are innocent. They are ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 29.9.2020.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Meanwhile, petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, petitioners – Kuldeep Kaur @ Lakho and Shillo – shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Counsel for the State, on instructions received from ASI Bahadur Singh, has submitted that in pursuance of the above said order the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further interrogation. It is further submitted that the antecedents of the petitioners are clean, as they have no other case of similar nature against them.

The petitioners being ladies as such are thus entitled for confirmation of the interim order dated 23.07.2020. Accordingly, the said order is confirmed and the petition stands disposed of.
