The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.76 dated 19.04.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 427, 452, 188, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sahnewal, Ludhiana.

On 22.07.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

"The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injuries attributed to the petitioner are on the right leg, knee, ankle and right hand of Parwinder Singh, brother of the complainant and the injuries are simple in nature. Learned counsel places reliance upon pendency of CRM-M No. 17925 of 2020 and CRM-M No.19093 of 2020 filed by co-accused in which interim bail has been granted and the cases are fixed for 26.8.2020.

Notice of motion for 26.8.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 27.7.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard with CRM-M No. 17925 of 2020”

Thereafter, vide order dated 26.08.2020, petitioner was again directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Kulwinder Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim orders dated 22.07.2020 and 26.08.2020 are made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to

do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under
Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
