The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.171 dated 16.05.2019 registered under Section 395 IPC and Sections 25, 54 of the Arms Act at Police Station Madlauda, District Panipat.

The allegations are of dacoity at midnight by a gang of dacoits. Cattle *bara* of the complainant was looted after pointing a pistol towards the complainant and Sunil. The dacoits looted

the cattles along with batteries, inverters, mobile phones and motorcycle. The petitioner was arrested in FIR No.97 dated 23.05.2019 under Sections 398, 401 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, Police Station Sanoli, in which he made a disclosure statement in respect of the present case. Thereafter, he was arrested in the present case and a spring actuated knife, inverter battery and vivo mobile phone were recovered from the petitioner. No cattle has been recovered. In every probability, cattles might have been slaughtered.

Looking to the seriousness of the offence, I do not wish to grant any indulgence in favour of the petitioner in this petition.

Dismissed.
