Instant petition for cancellation of the anticipatory bail granted to respondents No.2 to 6 has been moved at the hands of the complainant on the ground that the accused are threatening and pressurising the petitioner.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Paras Ram has submitted that complainant has already been examined and there is no perception of threat to the petitioner. He further submits that 9 out of 26 prosecution witnesses have appeared in the trial, including the petitioner. As the petitioner has been examined before the trial Court, there is no longer any threat to him. Accordingly, the petition is rendered infructuous.
