In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to respondent No.4 to make reference under Section 3 (H) National Highways Act, 1956 (for short 'the Act').

Reply on behalf of respondent No.3 & 4 has been filed, wherein it has been mentioned that the matter has been referred to the District Judge, Ludhiana under Section 3 (H) (4) of the Act. The relief claimed as such was also to that extent. It has also been averred that in view of the interim order passed by this Court on 30.04.2019, whereby it had been directed that the amount be disbursed to the private respondents, on furnishing of adequate security, the needful has been done.
