1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.948 dated 21.12.2019 registered under Section 24, Immigration Act, 1983 and Sections 406 and 420 IPC, at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 23.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the police and that his custodial interrogation is not required, besides the matter has been amicable settled.
4. Learned counsel for the complainant confirms that the matter has been amicably settled between the petitioner and respondent No.2.

5. Learned DAG, Haryana, on instructions from ASI Pawan, confirms that the petitioner joined investigation and was granted ad interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.

6. In view of the position as noted above, order dated 23.07.2020, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
