The petitioner has filed the present (first) petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short, "the Cr.P.C.") for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.64 dated 22.06.2015 registered at Police Station Ghuman, Batala, District Gurdaspur under Sections 376, 313 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "IPC") to which Sections 304-A, 201, 419, 120-B, 376-D and 302 of the IPC were added lateron.

Custody certificate along with short reply by way of affidavit of Lakhbir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala has been filed by the learned State counsel through e-mail print out of which is taken on record.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks dismissal of the present petition as withdrawn at this stage but prays for directions to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

However, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial on easing out of the restrictions imposed to prevent the spread of infection of Covid-19.
