The present petition has been filed under Section 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, alleging violation of the order dated 25.7.2019 passed by this Court in CWP-20310-2019. The operative part of the order dated 25.9.2019 reads as under:-

“3. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to pass a speaking order by objectively considering the contentions as raised in the legal notice dated 30.12.2017(Annexure P-6) along with the contents of the instant writ petition by treating the same as supplementary representation as also keeping in view the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner, as noted above, in accordance with law.

4. Let the needful be done within a

period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In the event the petitioner is found entitled to the benefits, as claimed by him, the same be accorded to him within a period of two months thereafter.

Disposed of.”
