2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.127, dated 26.06.2020, registered under Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Sadar, Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 23.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated with the Police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
