This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.89 dated 25.02.2019, under Sections 285/323/336/379-B/34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 (charge-sheeted under Sections 323/365/367/397 read with Section 34 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 Arms Act), registered at Police Station, Ambala City, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the parties are not disputing that the matter was compromised between the parties and one of the co-accused namely Gurpreet Singh @ Ghoda has already been granted regular bail vide order dated 24.07.2020 passed by this Court in CRM-M-34871-2019.

Heard.

Keeping in view that the matter has been compromised; period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that the trial will take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that no purpose will be served by detaining the petitioners any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ambala.
