This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 read with Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail from 26.7.2020 to 26.8.2020 for heart treatment in case FIR No.112 dated 27.8.2019, registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Sections 61 and 85 of NDPS Act added later on), at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

A bare perusal of the paper book shows that the recovery involved in the case is extremely high and extra-ordinary, comprising different kinds of prohibited intoxicants. Moreover, the State counsel submits that on a reference from the Civil Hospital, the petitioner was taken to Medical College, Amritsar. There the doctors had medically examined the petitioner and prescribed him the medicines. The petitioner is duly taking the medicines, as prescribed by the Medical College, Amritsar.

In view of the above , this Court does not find any ground to grant interim bail to the petitioner on medical ground.
