GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner-Daljeet Singh, stated to be aged 64 years, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the respondents, especially respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take action and decide the renewal request with regard to the renewal of the Arms Licence.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner based on pleadings submits that the petitioner had applied on 18.06.2019, in advance, for renewal of his arms licence which was going to expire on 08.08.2019. Thereafter, reference has been made to certain correspondence. It is then submitted that on 19.12.2019, the District Magistrate, Kurukshetra, had written to the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, to send the latest report. Learned counsel further submits that the request for renewal has not been finally decided by respondent No.2-The District Magistrate, Kurukshetra.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Harish Nain, Asstt. A.G, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to The District Magistrate, Kurukshetra i.e. respondent No.2 to decide the claims/pleas taken by the petitioner in representation/reply dated 13.12.2019 (Annexure P-5), within 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
