By means of this writ petition, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of quo-warranto, certiorari for quashing the order dated 17.07.2020 (Annexure P-10), whereby respondent No.3 was appointed as Interim Officiating Chairman of Bhakra Beas Management Board (BBMB), and for quashing the memorandum dated 17.08.2005 (Annexure P-11) pertaining to the delegation of powers for appointment. Further, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to appoint the petitioner as Interim Officiating Chairman of BBMB.

During the pendency of the petition, on 09.10.2020, learned

counsel for the petitioner had given up his claim for appointment of the petitioner as Interim Officiating Chairman, BBMB.

Today, Mr. Jain, learned senior counsel has produced the order dated 11.11.2020 passed by Government of India, Ministry of Power, which shows that Mr.Sanjay Shrivastava has been appointed as Chairman of BBMB.

The above fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that the petition is rendered infructuous.
