The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners, namely, Rupy and Jatinder Singh who claim themselves to be major have filed the present petition *inter alia* praying for protection of their life and liberty since they approached threat to the same having married against the wishes of their parents and relatives.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in this regard, a detailed representation dated 20.07.2020 (Annexure P-5) was submitted to respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned with above representation with regard to their alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur, expeditiously in accordance with law and

necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur (respondent No.2), so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.

Needless to say that the aforesaid order shall not be construed to be an expression as regards the validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
