GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Ninder Kaur, stated to be aged 62 years, has filed the present petition inter alia with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from the hands of respondents No.3 & 4.

Records of the case show that notice of motion in this case was issued on 23.07.2020.

Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, Assistant AG, Punjab, appears on behalf of the State.

Status report dated 31.08.2020, by way of affidavit of Rajbir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Vltaha, Camp at Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran, has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In the said status report, reference has been made to FIR No.108 dated 30.05.2020, which was registered under Sections 302,326, 325, 324,

323, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Khalra, against husband of the petitioner namely Sheetal Singh as well as Manjit Singh (son of the petitioner) and other persons.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the same/similar grievance, the petitioner had submitted a detailed representation dated 02.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (respondent No.2).

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned, with above representation dated 02.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) with regard to her alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (respondent No.2) as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (respondent No.2), by the Registry through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
