Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.330 dated 14.10.2019, registered under Section 379-A IPC (Section 379-A IPC deleted and 392, 34 IPC added lateron) at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel *inter alia* contends that there is two days delay in lodging the FIR. Name of the petitioner does not figure in the FIR. Petitioner has falsely been implicated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Ganpati. Out of three accused in the said FIR, two have been granted regular bail by the trial court. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner. No other case is registered against him.

First petition for grant of anticipatory bail was dismissed as withdrawn on 13.02.2020. Evading of his arrest by the petitioner since last eight months itself shows that he is a man of great criminal ilk.

Considering the overall circumstances and the fact of committing the offence of robbery, no ground is made out to entertain this second petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
