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**B.S. Walia, J. (VC)**

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to declare the petitioners as falling within the ambit of Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pension) Par-II Rules, 2009 read with connected/incidental provisions and amendments therein retrospectively w.e.f. the date of joining.
3. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioners have submitted representation Annexure P/5 dated 30.03.2019, but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1, to consider and decide the claim as made in representation Annexure P/5 dated 30.03.2019, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only.
5. Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioners.
6. Accordingly, in the light of the position as noted above and without commenting on the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claim as made in representation Annexure P/5 dated 30.03.2019, in accordance with law, by taking into account all aspects of the matter, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
