Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 13, who attacked on them on 25.09.2017. Further direction is sought, so as to direct respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to register an FIR against private respondent Nos.4 to 13.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 09.03.2018 of Sh.Harjinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Ghanaur, District Patiala, has already been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

Learned State Counsel while making reference to paragraph 5 of the affidavit dated 09.03.2018 submits that the enquiry in the case was

Singh is willing to lead his life with his wife Mandeep Kaur and wants to rehabilitate with his wife, but Mandeep Kaur is under pressure of her mother Jaswinder Kaur and brother Manpreet Singh, due to which, Mandeep Kaur consenting with her parental family does not want to go with her husband and the application submitted by the petitioners carries no truth.

He has further apprised this Court that since the complaint submitted by the petitioners was found to be false, even the proceedings under Section 182 IPC have been initiated against petitioner No.2 and the said proceedings are pending in the court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Rajpura.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
