The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner Brahma Nand through this invocation by way of civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has sought for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the service of the petitioner as qualifying service in Mewat cadre w.e.f 17.04.2012.

It is duly un rebutted stand of the petitioner that he was serving in Mewat District School Education (Group-B) and by virtue of service rules applicable to that service, the petitioner was entitled to exercise option to opt for Mewat cadre. After joining service on 21.12.1993 where he was regularized w.e.f. 05.05.1994 while being posted in Government Middle School Suthani, District Rewari.

In the light of oral submissions of the two sides directions are issued to the official respondents to duly consider the representation of the petitioner Annexure P-6 dated 16.03.2020 in the light of the Mewat District Education Group-B Rules 2012 and the law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of 03 months from the receipt of copy of this orders.
