[1]. Seen reply filed on behalf of the State.

[2]. It has been made out that final report was submitted in the case as no foul play was found in the death of the boy Aman since he had apparently fallen in the canal by slipping accidentally.

[3]. There is, however, no reference to the statement of suspect Rahul, a copy which is available on Page 24 of the paper-book, in which, he has mentioned about the other suspects Raja and Himanshu having hidden the clothes of the deceased and taking away his mobile phone.

[4]. In the view of this Court and in the given circumstances, this is a fit case warranting further investigation in the death of the minor boy Aman.

[5]. Respondent No.3 is directed to have further investigation conducted by a different officer not below the rank of Inspector.
