The petitioner is the accused in FIR No.79 dated 14.06.2020 on the file of Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914. By way of this petition, he seeks grant of anticipatory bail.

The case of the prosecution was that a raid was conducted at the spot where the petitioner was preparing illicit liquor but he managed to flee. However, 180 Kgs. of Lahan were recovered at the spot.

That apart, it appears that FIR Nos. 53 of 2018, 16 of 2014, 54 of 2018 and 82 of 2018 were registered against the petitioner, indicating that he is a habitual offender.

That being so, no cause is made out to extend any indulgence to the petitioner at this stage by granting him pre-arrest bail.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
