1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Reply by way of affidavit of Shri Asish Chaudhry, Dy. Superintendent of Police, Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar, has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner, who after arguing for some time, prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move an application for regular bail with directions being issued to the trial Court to consider and decide the application for regular bail as and when moved, as expeditiously as possible.

3. The same is not opposed to by Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of an application for regular bail being moved, the learned trial Court to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law. Since, the main petition has been dismissed as withdrawn, misc. application, pending if any, stands disposed of accordingly.
