B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move an application for regular bail with directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the application for regular bail as and when moved, as expeditiously as possible, preferably on the same day.
3. The limited prayer is not opposed to by the learned APP for UT Chandigarh.
4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of an application for regular bail

being moved, the learned trial Court to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law, expeditiously, if feasible on the same day.
