The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No. 156 dated 07.07.2020 on the file of Police Station Sadar Ratia, Tehsil Ratia, District Fatehabad, registered under various provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

The petitioner is not one of the named accused in this case. He was implicated on the strength of the disclosure statements of the co-accused, who claimed that they had purchased the contraband from him. 7.5 kilograms of poppy husk was recovered from the co-accused.

The petitioner asserted that no other case was registered against him under the provisions of the NDPS Act. This is confirmed by

Mr. Anant Kataria, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana.

Given the totality of the circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner would be entitled to relief, subject to conditions.

The petitioner is accordingly directed to forthwith join investigation in FIR No. 156 dated 07.07.2020 on the file of Police Station Sadar Ratia, Tehsil Ratia, District Fatehabad. Thereafter, in the event of his arrest in relation to the said case, he shall be released on bail upon his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of ₹20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
