The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No. 416 dated 03.09.2019 on the file of Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC. By way of this petition, she seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

The complainant in the case is none other than the husband of the petitioner. According to him, she left the matrimonial home and took jewellery, cash and a mobile phone with her.

The co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted anticipatory/regular bail.

Given the relationship between the parties and the nature of the

allegations, this Court is of the opinion that it would suffice if the petitioner

joins the investigation and her custodial interrogation may not be needed.

The petitioner is accordingly directed to forthwith join investigation in FIR No. 416 dated 03.09.2019 on the file of Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani. Thereafter, in the event of her arrest in relation to the said case, she shall be released on bail upon her furnishing a personal bond for a sum of ₹20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
