Petitioner seek anticipatory bail in a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.187 dated 05.11.2019 under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travels Professional Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Mehatpur District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties and a separate petition bearing CRM-M-27841-2020 has been filed.

State Counsel submits that in terms of the order dated 24.07.2020, petitioner has joined investigation, which fact has been vouched for by the State Counsel, on instructions from ASI-Tarlochan Singh. He further submits that petitioner's antecedents are clean and she is not involved in any other case of similar nature and is not required for further investigation.

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In view of the above facts, no useful purpose would be served by taking the petitioner in custody.

Accordingly, this Court is of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the petitioner, in the facts and circumstances of the present case is not necessary. In such circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that interim order dated 24.07.2020 is liable to be confirmed. Ordered accordingly.
