The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 118 dated 08.07.2020, under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kotwali Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is the outcome of a monetary dispute between the brothers. The petitioner and the complainant are brothers and were partners of a firm. The petitioner has also filed a civil suit with regard to the partnership which is pending adjudication before the trial Court. He also contends that as the dispute is between the brothers, they shall try to settle the matter amicably.

This Court, by the order dated 24.07.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the allegations against the petitioner are serious and, therefore, he is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 24.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
